*Sts'ailes purchased this historic property in the spring of 2009. Built as Fenn Lodge in 1903 as a private home, this 10,000 square foot gem was remodelled fifteen years ago into a bed and breakfast facility. It features nine unique guest rooms with private bathrooms.*

The house includes a library, living room with a fireplace, twenty-four seat dining hall, regulation size billiards table, large gourmet-style kitchen, free wifi, and meeting rooms – a perfect place for your family or group event.

The lovely eighty-seven acre property features a secluded waterfall (providing electricity ten months of the year), creek, salt water pool and a peaceful meditation labyrinth. Nearby are golf, skiing, boating and wildlife viewing opportunities.
