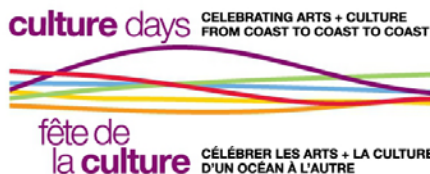
Upcoming Info Session Schedule
