PEMBERTON MUSEUM

May 19th – November

Take a step back in time and explore the Pioneer Village. Learn about Port Pemberton's early days as a stopping point along the historic Harrison-Lillooet gold rush trail of 1858, the coming of the rail in 1914 and the settlement that followed. Visit the Lilwat7ul Culture Centre to learn about our Lil'wat People and to see a variety of work from the artists of Lil'wat Nation. Open Monday to Friday from 8:30-4:30, the Culture Centre is located within the Ullus Band Office. Cultural Heritage programs are a big part of the Centre and many activities are offered year round to community members. Traditional dancing, drum making, basket weaving and beading are just some of the programs that are currently being conducted. There are also many paintings, carvings; cedar weaved items, inner and outer cedar root work and plenty more on consignment from Lil'wat Artists.

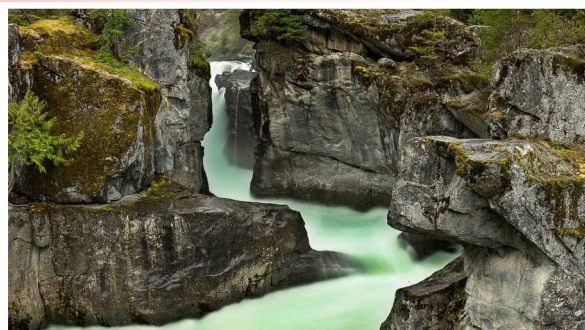

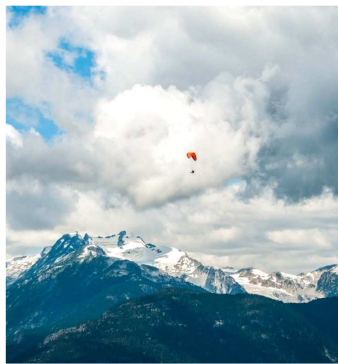
TEA AND TALES (MUSEUM)
