Polygon Gallery

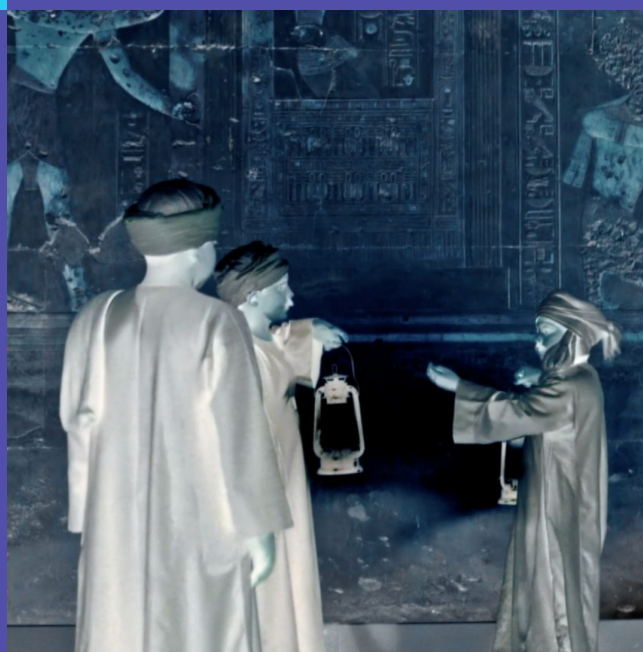
October 17 2019 – January 12 2020
