ARTE funktional GALLERY & ASHPA NAIRA STUDIO Vernon

Located on the westside of Okanagan Lake, ARTE funktional is a contemporary art gallery that features original art in a home and garden setting. In the same location, guests can visit ASHPA NAIRA STUDIO where multidisciplinary artist Carolina Sanchez de Bustamante creates contemporary art in sculpture, ceramics, textile and architectural ceramics. Visitors can learn, explore and appreciate art made at the studio, and find that special gift or add to their art collection.

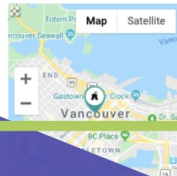

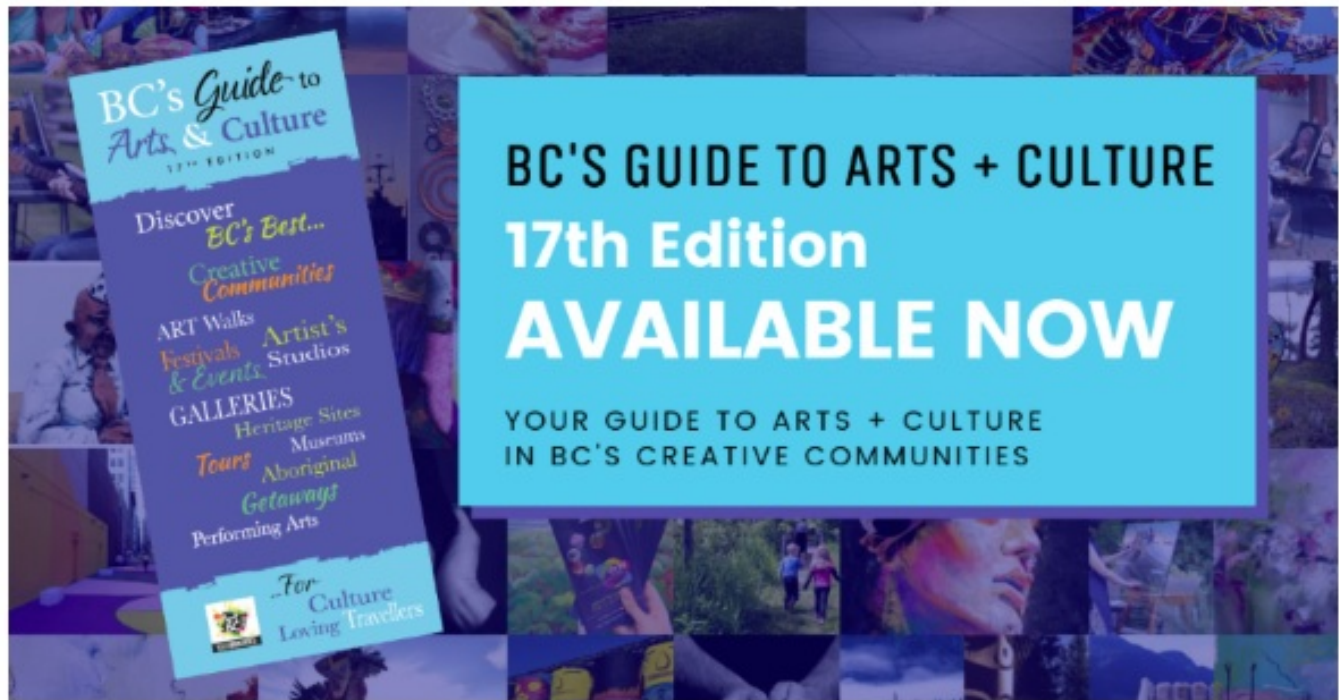
