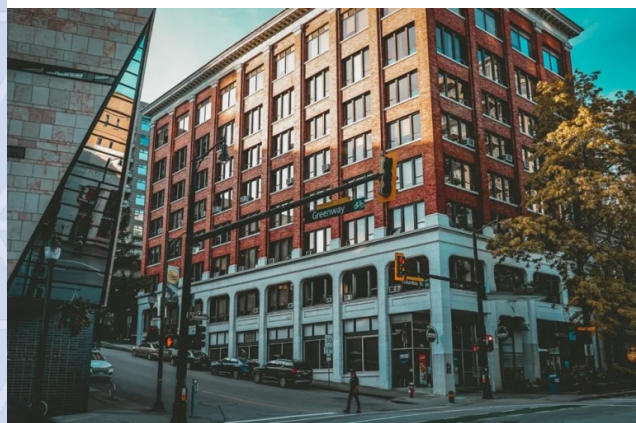

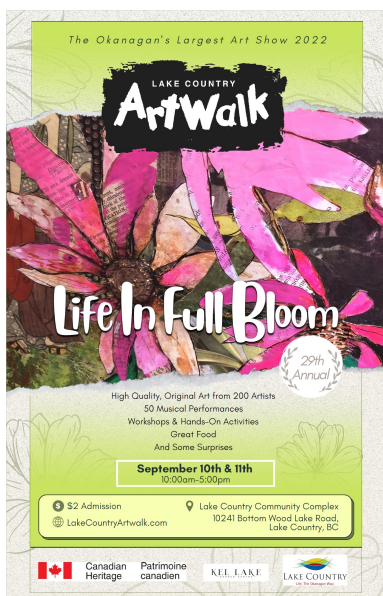


Richmond Public Art

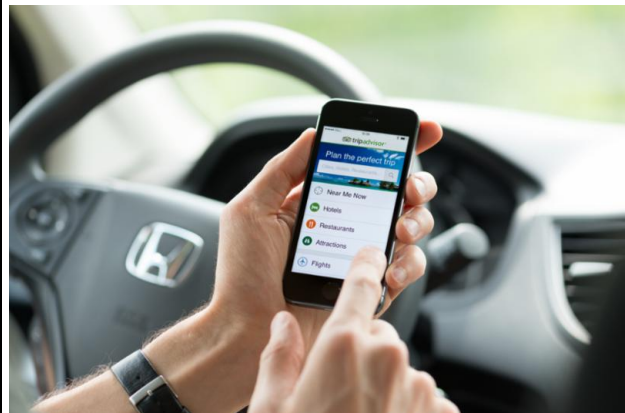

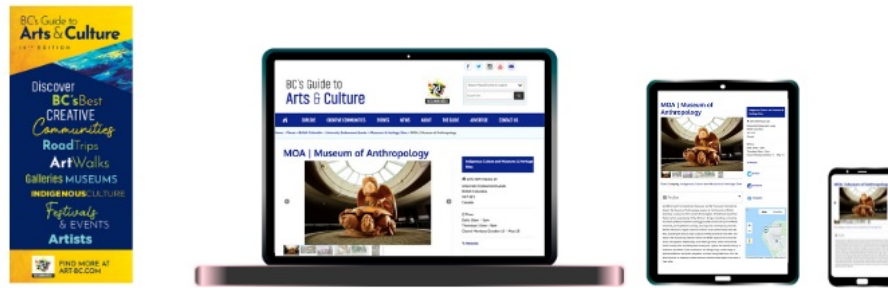
