Chinese Canadian Museum

The Chinese Canadian Museum is located in the historic Vancouver Chinatown. Housed inside the oldest brick building in Chinatown, this museum is the first of its kind and honours the history, contributions, and heritages of Chinese Canadians while elevating and engaging with voices and communities across the country.

The museum is open from Wednesday to Sunday from 10 A.M. to 5 P.M. and on statutory Mondays.

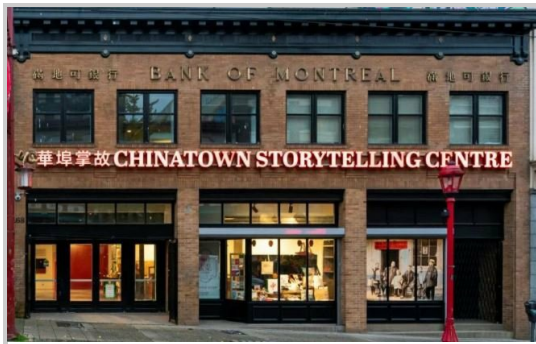
Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Garden

Located near Vancouver's Chinatown, Dr. Sun Yat-Sen Classical Chinese Garden is a registered museum and top tourist attraction. This Ming Dynasty-style garden-home, the first of its kind outside China, was created through a collaboration between the community, the Canadian Government, and China. The garden hosts cultural events, guided tours, and educational programs.

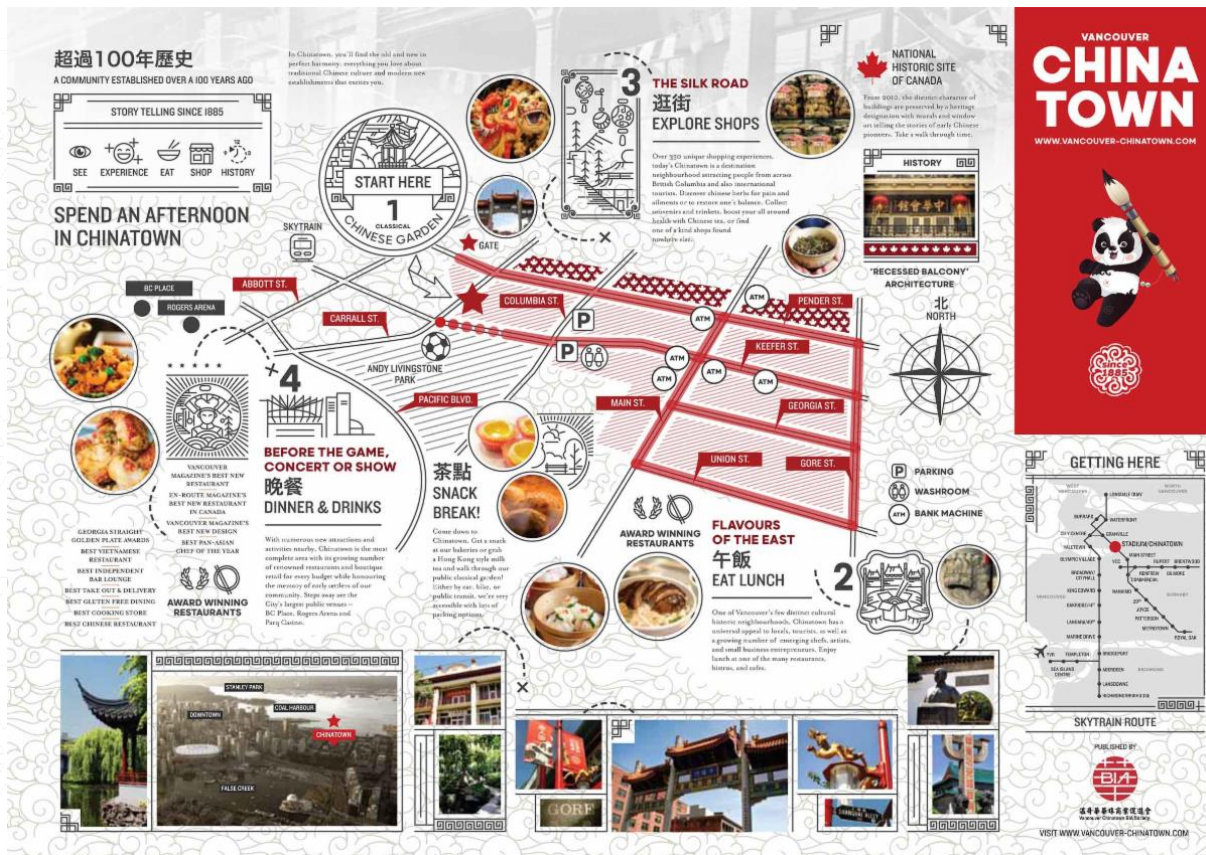
A Wok Around Chinatown

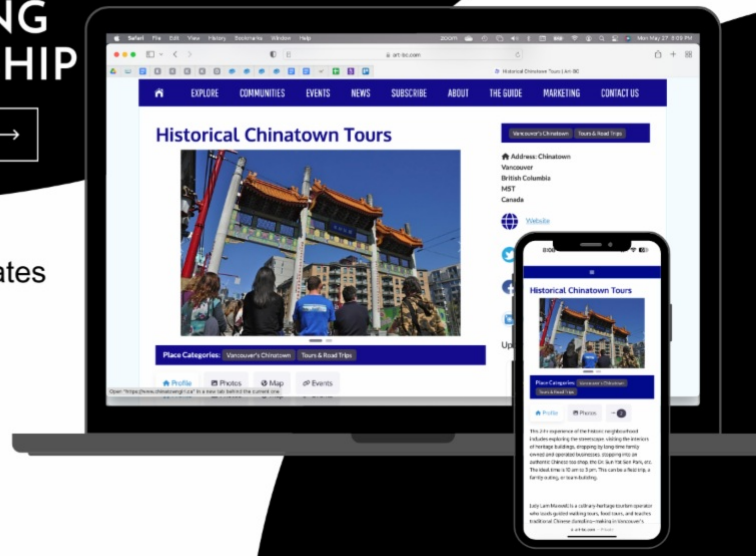
