## **Discover BC's Museums & Historical Sites**


Immerse yourself in our vibrant history at BC's Museums and Heritage sites! Deepen your understanding of our Indigenous People's cultural traditions. Learn and experience the early days of farming, fishing, mining, logging, and yes, even sports in the province. Across BC stories abound in museums and heritage sites awaiting your engagement.



#### **Branscombe House**

Branscombe House is located at 4900 Steveston Highway and is one of the earliest homes built in the area; as such it is significant for its historical association to **Steveston** and for reflecting the pattern of commercial and related residential development that occurred in Steveston's early history.

The Branscombe House **Artist-in-Residence** is selected annually via an **Open Call**.



## Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame

In 1965, after considerable lobbying efforts from a group of passionate lacrosse enthusiasts, the Canadian Lacrosse Hall of Fame was created to serve as a permanent way to recognize and honour box players, field players, builders, teams who have contributed to the rich history of lacrosse in Canada.

Located in **New Westminster** (which has its own unique lacrosse history), the hall serves as not only a



#### **BC Farm Museum**

Located in historic **Fort Langley** the BC Farm Museum has the province's largest collection of pioneer and agricultural artifacts.

Something of interest for every age. Kids love our **Scavenger Hunt** (with a prize) and after Covid19, rope making, tomato and egg sorting demonstrations. Visitors learn how people lived without electricity and can see first-hand several wooden ice boxes (early refrigerators), see early windmills that pump water and produce light.... nearing **100 years** old and still running!

# Courtenay & District Museum

The Courtenay and District Museum was established in **1961** as a non-profit organization with the mandate to collect, preserve and interpret natural and cultural heritage of the **Comox Valley** region. Program subjects include fossils, geology, First Nations history, pioneer settlement history, social history of the Comox Valley, logging and lumber history, river way study, as well as, a series of changing exhibitions.


