Downtown Vancouver's public gallery is named after the acclaimed Haida artist Bill Reid (1920-1998).

The Gallery showcases the permanent collection of Bill Reid and changing exhibitions of contemporary Northwest Coast art. Permanent Collection of Bill Reid's work – Stunning gold and silver jewelry – Monumental sculptures – Towering totem pole carved by James Hart in tribute to Bill Reid.

The Gallery Shop offers a selection of original works and prints by local Northwest Coast artists, distinctive jewelry, accessories, books, cards, and more.

#### Spirits of the West Coast Art Gallery

Spirits of the West Coast Art Gallery specializes in a large variety of authentic Northwest Coast Indigenous Artwork and Jewelry by Master Artists of Haida, Kwakwaka'wakw or Kwakiutl, Coast Salish, and West Coast descent.

Enjoy the beautiful selection of native masks, paddles, argillite carvings, sculptures, prints, silver and gold jewelry, rings, wedding bands, bracelets, and pendants.

The gallery is an excellent opportunity to learn more about the art and cultures of the Northwest Coast First Nations and find unique one-of-a-kind works of art.

Their shop features items such as mixed media beadwork, pine needle, birch bark, cedar bark jewelry, and baskets.

They also have an assortment of drums, rattles, leatherwork, bone, semi-precious stones and medicinal products.

From the Nihazkampx, Okanagan, Lakota, and Cree nations.



#### Nisga'a Museum

Welcome to Hli Goothl Wilp-Adokshl Nisga'a, a name representing the four tribesthat make up the Nisga'a Nation.

The museum displays artifacts of all four peoples within its permanent exhibition, an assemblage of 300+ art objects that left the Nass Valley in the latter part of the 19th Century and early part of the 20th Century. During the struggle for our treaty, Nisga'a elders and leaders fought to ensure this scattered legacy would find its way back home.

Now, housed in a permanent place of honour, this treasury of Nisga'a culture ranks as one of the preeminent collections of Northwest Coast aboriginal art.
