Art Gallery at Evergreen Evan Lee: Forged

Vancouver-based Chinese Canadian artist **Evan Lee** is best known for making lens-based images in new and unexpected ways. Referred to as a member of the "**post-photography**" generation, Lee often makes camera-less photographs: high-resolution images captured using a flatbed scanner.

Using such techniques, he explores the limits and possibilities of photography through experimentation, adaptability and an economy of means.
