The spectacular Nk'Mip Desert Cultural Centre (pronounced in-kameep) is a state-of-the-art interpretive centre and is an architectural marvel sensitively constructed into a hillside.

Extensive indoor and outdoor exhibit galleries create a fun, interactive learning environment with hands-on displays, education stations and two multi-media theatre experiences.

The Gallery is the most extensive public gallery in North Okanagan and offers approximately 20 exhibitions per year for public viewing. Admission is by donation.
